- 1 Rules** The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 2 Eligibility and Entry** The regatta is open to all boats of the J/24 class. Entrants must meet all ownership, class membership, and measurement requirements. Class Rule 2.5.3 is changed to allow a completed yacht Measurement Form Part D in lieu of a current Measurement Certificate. Yachts may be entered by advance registration, or by registering at the regatta site during registration hours. Advance registration is strongly encouraged.

- 4 Fees** Entry fees include entry to the competition, Arrival Happy Hour for all competitors and crew, beer bracelets for competitors and crew over age 21, Regatta dinner on Saturday for all competitors and crew. Friday dinner (Lowcountry Beaufort Stew) is optional with separate fee. Hamburger lunches will be available at extra cost on Fri before competition and Sun after competition.

- 6 Measurement** Crew will be weighed during Registration hours on Thursday, Mar 20 and Friday, Mar 21. Persons requiring boat measurement should contact fleet captain Roger Dougal ([dougal@engr.sc.edu](mailto:dougal@engr.sc.edu)) to obtain a list of available class measurers.
- 7 Sailing Instructions** Available at the registration table after 1400 on Mar 20, 2009, or from the regatta web site after Mar 15.
- 8 Courses** Courses will be windward/leeward as described in the Sailing Instructions.
- 9 Scoring and Penalty System** Each boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores using RRS 89.3 (Appendix A4.1 "Low Point System") with no throwouts (Changes Appendix A-Scoring, A2). Race committee will attempt to set as many races as are practical. Three races constitute a series. The percentage penalty, RRS 44.3, will apply.
- 10 Launching, Hauling, Docking, Parking** A crane will be available to launch and haul during the following hours (approximately): Thursday 4 to 6 PM, Friday 8-11 AM, and Sunday following the last race. There is no lifting charge. A gin pole is available. Yachts must be wet sailed during the Regatta. Berthing will be provided at the Columbia Sailing Club. The order of haul out after the regatta will be based on bow numbers, assigned according to order of receipt of pre-registrations. Parking, launching, and docking instructions will be provided at the club entrance. Boats may be parked at the club before or after the regatta for up to two weeks with advance approval.
- 11 Prizes** Trophies will be awarded to the top six boats, with crew trophies for the top 3 boats. First place trophies for individual races will be awarded daily. Also, the 1st place winner's name will be engraved on CSC's *Perilita Trophy* and on the J/24 perpetual trophy. The highest placing member of Fleet 67 will be similarly recognized on Fleet 67's perpetual trophy.
- 12 Disclaimer of Liability** Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in

conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

**13 Insurance**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.

**14 Miscellaneous**

Camping is available on club grounds. Dogs are not permitted on club grounds.
